Pursuit Race, Starting and Finishing off Quissett Harbor

Open to PHRF-NE Racing and Cruising Classes

Notice of Race

1. RULES and REGULATIONS

1.1. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

1.1.1. There will be no limit to the number of crew or the number of sails carried or used if they conform to the boat's rating certificate.

1.1.2. Each boat must have a minimum of two people on board.

2. ELIGIBILITY

2.1. The QYC Round the Bay Race is open to single-hulled boats with a valid 2016 PHRF-NE rating certificate.

2.1.1. There will be two classes, Racing and Cruising.

Racing Class: Asymmetrical spinnakers may be used as per PHRF-NE By-Laws.

Cruising Class: Use of any type of spinnaker (including cruising spinnakers), double headed headsail combinations (Luffs attached to the forestay) or mizzen staysails is not permitted.

2.1.2. Boats wishing to change class should notify the race committee before 1140 on race day.

2.1.3. Eligible boats may enter by: Completing the online registration form at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/12882>, and uploading or mailing the boat's PHRF-NE

certificate according to the instruction on the online registration form and paying the required fee to Quissett Yacht Club by September 8, 2016.

2.2. Late entries, received after the due date specified on the race registration form, *may* be accepted by the Race Committee up until the Committee Boat leaves the dock. A late fee will be assessed for all late entries. Late entries may not be listed on the Scratch Sheet and may be assigned a starting time already on the scratch sheet, which may be later than their rating would call for.

3. FEES

3.1. Entry for the QYC Round the Bay Race is \$50 for US Sailing Members and \$55 for Non-Members.

3.2. An additional \$25 will be charged for all late entries.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1. Registration: Open until 2400 EST on September 8, 2016.

4.2. Late Registration: Available from September 9 through 1030 EST on September 10, 2016.

4.3. Scratch Sheet: Available on the registration website by 1700 EST on September 9, 2016.

4.4. First Start: 1200 unless postponed.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. The sailing instructions will be available prior to September 1, 2016.

6. Venue

6.1. The race will be sailed in Buzzard’s Bay.

6.2. The start will be located outside Quissett Harbor. Approximate starting pin location: lat. 41.32.9, long. 70.40.2.

7. COURSES

7.1. The Round the Bay Race is a pursuit race. Because of the pursuit start, the handicaps will be calculated ahead of time. In order to give maximum flexibility in setting a course best suited to the prevailing conditions, the handicaps, and therefore the starting times, will be calculated for courses of different lengths, designated as Starting Time W, X, Y and Z on the Scratch Sheet.

8. PRIZES

8.1. Boston Yacht Club Trophy – First finisher

Harbor Challenge Trophy – First Quissett Yacht Club finisher

Round the Bay Race Trophies – First three finishers in Racing and Cruising divisions

8.2. The Race Committee reserves the right to limit classes or awards based on number of entries.

9. MANAGEMENT

9.1. The race will be managed by the Round the Bay Race Committee who shall have the authority to interpret the rules and conditions of the race, to decide protests and to reject the entry of any boat at any time prior to the preparatory signal for the start of the race that, in its opinion, is unseaworthy or does not comply with the spirit of the rules and conditions of the race.

10. OWNERS', SKIPPER'S AND CREWS' RESPONSIBILITIES

10.1. The safety of a boat and her crew is the sole responsibility of the skipper, who must assure that the boat is thoroughly seaworthy and manned by a competent crew. The skipper of a boat must be satisfied as to the soundness of the hull, spars, rigging, sails and all gear. The skipper must assure that all equipment is properly maintained and stowed and that the crew knows where it is kept and how it is to be used.

Neither the establishment of equipment regulations nor any inspecting of a boat in any way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibility of a boat's skipper. It is the sole and exclusive responsibility of the skipper and crew of a boat to decide whether or not to start or continue in a race.

The Quissett Yacht Club is in no way responsible for accidents or injury to boats or personnel suffered in any way or from any cause during or related to the QYC Round the Bay Race.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1. Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. See rule 4. Decision to Race. The

organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the race.
